

# Steps to Obtain Your MAT Waiver

**1**

## Take 8-hour MAT waiver course

PCSS-MAT offers several free courses each month. Find 8-hour medication assisted treatment (MAT) course schedules on [PCSS-MAT](#).

## Check Your Eligibility

To apply for a waiver you must have a valid medical license and an active DEA number. Apply for a DEA number with Drug Enforcement Agency's Diversion Control Division (Registration Support) [here](#).

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## Complete your Notice of Intent Form

Once you have finished the 8-hour course, complete the NOI form [online](#) and submit it to the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) for review.

**3**

## Forward your Certificate of Completion to SAMHSA

When you complete the 8-hour waiver training, PCSS-MAT will send you via email your certificate of completion. Fax the Certificate of Completion to 301 576-5237 or [email](#) it to SAMHSA.

**4**

Once SAMHSA has obtained all documentation, the process requires approximately 45 days.
